Dear Parents,

This year we will be offering an E-Learning program five days per week. It will be a redesigned electronic instructional approach. This method of E-Learning will be different from what was offered in the Spring of 2020. Classes will be broadcast live via Google Classroom within a secure, private domain, to which only St. Paul students will have access. Since the classes are being broadcast live, and students will be watching while teachers are giving instruction, they will be able to ask questions and receive answers in real-time. Students will also be able to participate fully by showing and sharing their knowledge with their classmates and teachers. Any questions regarding the E-Learning option can be directed to the reopening committee at reopening@stpaulaurora.org.

The following guidelines will be required of an E-Learning student:

- By choosing to enroll in E-Learning, you are agreeing that your child will be online whenever school is in session, until your child is committed to return to in-school learning full time.
- Tuition cost remains the same for those who choose E-Learning.
- By choosing to enroll in E-Learning, you are committing your student to be online simultaneously with the class that is at school.
- Students are required to be online during normal school hours.
- Missed classes will be considered absences.
- Absentees are required to make-up missed work per school policy. Absent students are required to notify the school office and classroom teacher.
- Absences will follow the school attendance policy (see p. 4 of the student handbook).
- Homework due dates will be the same for both in-school and E-Learning students.
- E-Learning students will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities, including athletics.
- Teachers reserve the right to remove E-Learning students from the class broadcast for any of the following reasons:
 - Their face not being in full view of their camera
 - Not wearing appropriate attire for class
 - Using electronic devices during class such as: Switch, TV, XBOX, etc.
 - Showing disrespect to the teacher by laying down, napping, sleeping, etc.

- Consistent side bar conversations with others in the household
- Continued removal from E-Learning sessions will follow the protocol below:
 - After five removals from class, there will be a meeting with parents.
 - If behavior continues after meeting with parents, a suspension with no grades will be given to the student.
 - If behavior continues after suspension, students will no longer be able to continue with E-Learning.
